

Activity: Daily Chores

Instructions: Simple chores can give young children a sense of purpose. Choose a few chores to talk about with your child. Explain to your child what a chore is and create a list of chores that your child is responsible for. Young children need reminders when something is new. Give your child reminders about their chores and show them a few times how to complete the chore. A few examples of chores for young children are below.

Chores for young children

- pick up toys
- water plants
- set table
- make bed
- feed/water pets
- pick up sticks/yard debris
- fold laundry
