## ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Energy Assistance Program assists low-income households with the high cost of their home energy. Approved applicants receive a one-time winter heating benefit along with a summer cooling benefit. Window air conditioner units are available to at-risk households with qualifying medical conditions through the Summer Cool program. Energy Education is provided, outlining ways to conserve energy within the home in order to lower utility costs.

In Program Year 2020 (November 2019 – July 2020), the following benefits were provided:
