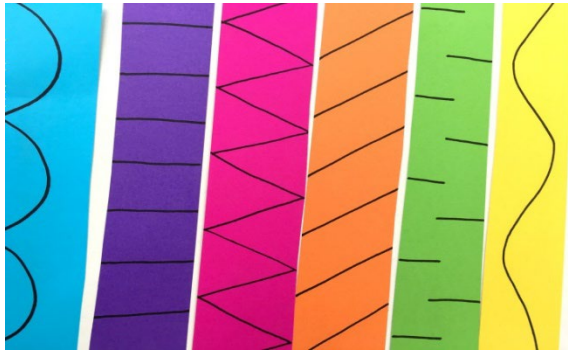


Happy face/crazy hair

For this first activity you will need paper (colorful paper is fun, but optional), a marker that will clearly show up on the paper of choice, and a pair of scissors for your child. Draw different types of lines on the paper so that your child can practice their cutting and fine motor skills. Encourage them to try and stay on the lines that you have drawn for them.

The second activity is just as fun and simple. Just use either a toilet paper roll, or paper towel roll and draw different fun faces towards the center of each roll that you have. The space at the top will be the “hair”. Your child may want to color the top of the roll before using scissors to cut and style that hair as they see fit. This can be a good time to talk about colors with your child, or even talk about different emotions that you can draw on the rolls.
