



Activity Name: Number Hide and Seek

Instructions: Using a recycled piece of cardboard or a few pieces of paper write numbers 2 through 9 approximately 2 inches in size and 2 to 3 inches apart. Then using a deck of cards have your child sort out all the numbers from the face and ace cards. Taking the pile of cards with numbers on them hide them either outside or around the house.



Then have your child find the numbers you can encourage your child to move in different ways as they hunt for the cards (jump, run, skip, gallop, tip toe, etc). When they find a card they bring it to the number paper and match the numbers. Ask them what number it is before they place the card on top of the number on the paper. If your child needs help identifying the number have your child count the spots on the card. To make the activity easier you could only hide one number at a time to help reinforce that number's recognition. As your child understands the game, you can increase the amount of cards that are hidden.

Learning Objective: This activity allows your child great movement opportunities, number recognition and counting as well as classifying. 4, 5, 8b, 13, 20a, 20c
